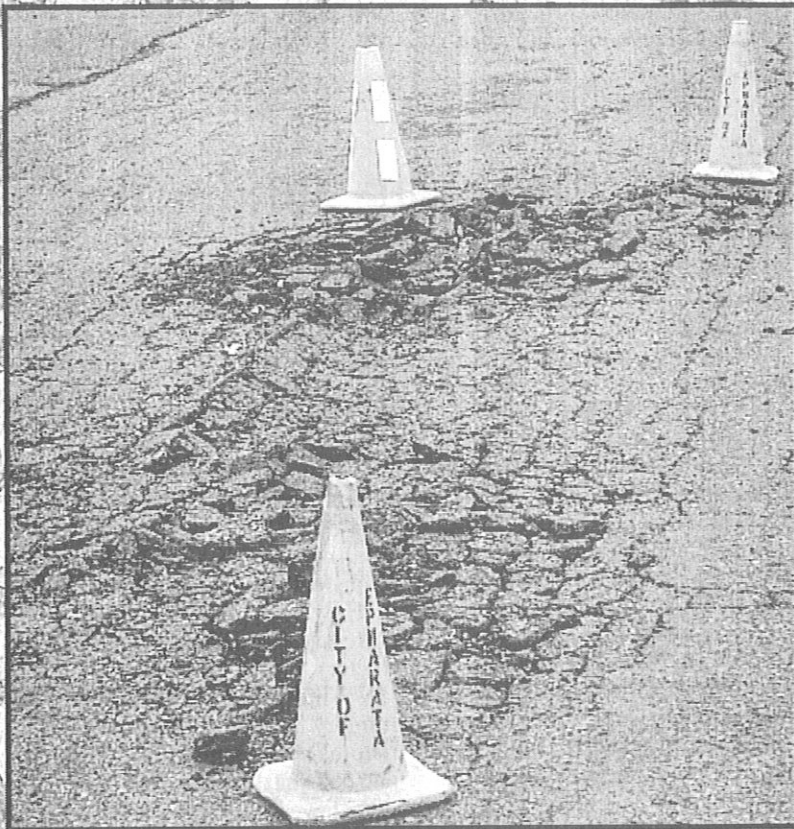


TIRED OF POTHOLES?
