

# CONSTRUCTION ANNOUNCEMENT-23

Phase-III of the Ephrata Waterline & Street Replacement Project is beginning week 23 of 28; due to rain delays last Spring, this project will take several weeks longer. This four-year, \$10-million dollar project will replace 24-miles of aging waterlines and failing streets.

**Next week, 30 August-03 September, all of the following streets/areas will be impacted by construction:**

**Southwest Area: Pulverization of the roads will begin on Monday. Crews will work generally from the south to the north. Cars will need to be moved off of the streets during this process. Paving will follow as soon as possible.**

Watch for temporary street closures and intermittent water interruptions. Residents may still experience air in their waterlines during the construction process due to flushing. This is normal and will continue until all the work is completed.

**Swanson Addition and A-Street: Final asphalt patching will take place when the pavers arrive for the Southwest Area.**

Crews from Advanced Excavation will generally work a 4-10 schedule; work starting at 7:00am and ending at 5:30pm, Monday-Thursday.

All cars will need to stay off of these streets until construction crews reopen the roadway. **Cars not off the street shall be towed at the owner's expense.**

If we all cooperate together, our new waterlines and beautiful new streets will be finished on time, and under budget. If you have questions at any time, contact City Hall at 754-4601.
