

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE-12

ROAD CLOSED TO THRU TRAFFIC

Phase-I of the Ephrata Waterline & Street Replacement Project has completed week 9 of 18.

This four-year, \$10-million dollar project will replace 24-miles of aging waterlines and streets.

Next week, 25-29 August 2008, the project will be excavating, working, and/or paving on all Northeast streets. This includes L-Street from Division Street to 1st Avenue NE, K-Street from Division to 2nd, and all of J, Ivy, H, G, F, E, D, and Lincoln, Nob Hill, and Jefferson-Streets from Division to 3rd Avenue NE.

Grading and shaping will take place on J, K, and L-Streets; service line work will be taking place on Ivy and H-Streets; and mainlines will be installed on F and E-Streets. All other roads will have pre-excavation work taking place, so please drive with caution.

All cars will need to stay off of these streets until construction crews reopen the roadway.

Cars not off the street shall be towed at the owner's expense.

If we all cooperate together, our new waterlines and beautiful new streets will be finished on time, and under budget. If you have questions at any time, contact City Hall at 754-4601.
