

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE-6

Phase-I of the Ephrata Waterline & Street Replacement Project has completed week 4 of 16.

This four-year, \$10-million dollar project will replace 24-miles of aging waterlines and streets.

Next week, 14-18 July 2008, the project will be excavating, working, and/or paving on all of K-Street from Division Street to 2nd Avenue NE, and all of H, I, J, and K-Streets from 3rd Avenue to Division Street.

All cars will need to stay off of these streets until construction crews reopen the roadway. Local traffic should avoid this area as well, so as not to interfere or delay this important work.

Cars not off the street shall be towed at the owner's expense.

Due to press deadlines, this notice is intended as a general estimate. Please give all due attention to signage and traffic controls when driving in the Northeast Area.

Also, watch for notices in the paper, delivered in the mail, on the City's website, and posted on your door, as to where and when to move vehicles.

If we all cooperate together, our new waterlines and beautiful new streets will be finished on time, and under budget. If you have questions at any time, contact City Hall at 754-4601.
